

Cornerstone Research Guidelines

You will need to include a WORK CITED page (MLA format) to document any sources you use for any part of this project – individual or group.

(Bookmark this address if you plan to go to college because you WILL use it—whether your professors require MLA or APA, many of THEM will use this as a reference when they are checking up on your format.)

You should be using research to assist you in creating strong explications and mimeses. You do NOT need to use parenthetical citations (except if you use direct or paraphrase quotes in your explication), but you do need to list all resources that helped to shape your work.

Your GROUP presentation should include AT **MINIMUM two paper sources** (meaning a book, a professional journal, etc. – and keep in mind that our library has some contemporary author books that would work well for this assignment) and at least **two credible online sources**. (*How do you know a site is credible?*)
